





2. The Arctic in the Age of Globalization.	8th (2nd)	5	Written exam: 48h take-home assignment (max 10 pages) Graded.
3. Project oriented module (internship) with an emphasis on one or more dimensions of Arctic Studies. Alternatively, relevant studies in another programme /university with an emphasis on one or more dimensions of Arctic Studies.	9th (3rd)	30	Written exam based on internship (according to 'home' Master Curriculum)
4. Master's thesis with an emphasis on one or more dimensions of Arctic Studies.	10th (4th)	30	Written exam. Graded


